

Assembly & Operating Instructions Ironmaster LANDMINE Attachment


CONTENTS:

1X LAND MINE Attachment Unit and Hardware is preassembled.





Assembly: This attachment can be bolted on the machine frame in various locations. We recommend the inside rear location as shown. Remove one bolt from the base frame. Next, with LAND MINE Attachment bracket facing rearward, and making sure bracket is square to frame, (see illustration for correct orientation) reinstall BASE bolt with LANDMINE Attachment in place and tighten securely.



Operation:

This device is designed for use as a pivot point for various barbell row exercises. Insert barbell end into the sleeve completely and check insertion before each use. Check clearance or full range of motion before use. Check bolt and nuts periodically. Unit does not require lubrication but light machine oil or grease may be used at the joints if needed.

This attachment only for Olympic barbell use with the Ironmaster IM1500 and IM2000 models. Not intended for any other use. Load limit 350 lbs.
